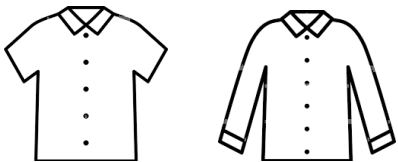
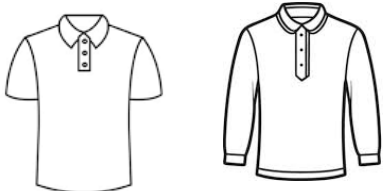
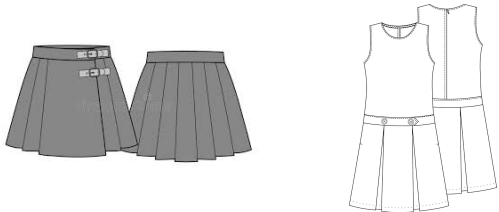
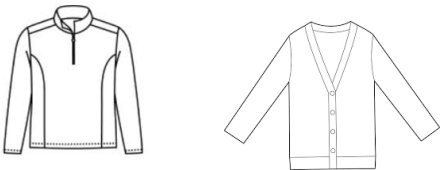


OSL 2026-2027 School Uniform Guidelines

Please read the clothing guidelines carefully. While we do not require a specific brand of uniform, the guidelines clearly describe a uniform that should be worn each day. Clothing may be purchased from any retailer but must conform with the color and style guidelines described below.



<u>Tops</u> All shirts must have a collar and be of a solid color: white, black, blue (light, dark, royal). Below are acceptable shirts to wear as part of the school uniform. Other shirts are not permitted.	<u>Bottoms</u> All bottoms must be of a solid color: black, khaki, or blue. Below are acceptable bottoms to wear as part of the school uniform. Other bottoms are not permitted. Absolutely no leggings, athletic, stretch, or yoga pants. NO spandex. No Cargo Pants or Cargo Shorts.
Oxford (button-down) Shirt 	Pants - casual dress pant (not stretch) Preferably with pockets and belt loops 
Polo (golf) Shirt 	Skirts and Jumpers - fingertip rule Must be as long as fingertips held at sides with arms relaxed 
LAYERING ¼ Zip or Cardigan (sweater) OSL Fleece jackets are also acceptable. Long sleeve t-shirts for <u>layering under the shirts</u> above are acceptable. None of these items may be worn alone. 	Shorts - knee length short pants Not athletic shorts. Preferably with pockets and belt loops 
OSL Hoodies, t-shirts, and faith-based shirts are permitted on Friday Spirit Days. On colder days, leggings (solid blue, black, white, tan) may be worn UNDER a skirt or jumper. Jeans are permitted ONLY on FRIDAY Spirit Days.	

Shoes

**All shoes must have a closed back. Tennis shoes and casual dress shoes are preferred.
No Crocs, slippers, or slide-on shoes.**

Tennis Shoe (required on PE days)

Any tennis shoe is acceptable.

Casual Dress Shoe or Boot

Any casual dress shoe or boot is acceptable.

**During winter weather, snow boots are required for outdoor recess.
A change of shoes must be provided for the classroom.**

Accessories

Accessories (jewelry, make-up and nails) must not cause a distraction to learning.

Hair

Hair must be a natural color and be kept away from the face so as not to interfere with vision.

Hats

Must be removed when inside the building.
